Chalon-sur-Saône - Côte Chalonnaise

HE PROGRAM

Arrive in **Chalon-sur-Saône** and meet up with your quide for a tour of the town. Capital of the Merovingian kingdom of Burgundy during the Middle Ages, the town was also at the origin of the many fairs that sealed its prominence. Chalon-sur-Saone still has some lovely squares of half-timbered houses and all kinds of beautiful classical mansions in its old town. Depart afterwards for the villages of the Côte Chalonnaise. After having passed through the village of Dracy le Fort, stop for a luncheon of Burgundian specialities.

Start of the afternoon

Guided tour of the Château de Germolles. The best preserved residence of the Dukes of Burgundy and one of the last remaining princes palace from the Middle-Ages. Continue on to Mercurey, a charming village on the Côte Chalonnaise famous for the quality of its wines. Visit a wine cellar, discover the magic of the winemaking process, the different varietals and terroirs, and taste 4 wines typical of the area.

Return to Chalon-sur-Saône

Check into your hotel and enjoy a typical Burgundian dinner.

DAY 2:

Beaune - Chalon-sur-Saône

After breakfast

Meet up with your driver at your hotel and head for

Beaune.

Guided tour of the Hôtel Dieu. Located right in the heart

of the town and known for its varnished tile roof and gothic facades. Tour the kitchens, the "Poor ward", the apothecary and the Founder's courtyard. Discover the 15th century Polyptyque, made up of 9 panels and attributed to the Flemish artist Rogier van der Weyden, which represent the Last Judgement.

Lunch in a restaurant

Guided tour of Beaune by little tourist train. Free time to wander around Beaune. Then head towards the Côte de Beaune and its famous

vineyards with such evocative names as Pommard, Volnay, Puligny Montrachet, Meursault.. Back on the road towards Chalon-sur-Saône.
