Leave Chalon-sur-Saône in the morning aboard a luxury coach

9.30am:

You will arrive in the middle of the vineyards at a well-known chateau in Mercurey, famous wine making village on the Côte Chalonnaise.

You will be welcomed to the Chateau and will start with a tour of the vines. An explication will be given of how the vine works, its annual cycle, the "terroirs", classifications and appellations.

Then you will visit the beautiful historic cellars. During the wine-tasting explanations will be given on the grape harvest, wine making, maturing and keeping/storing wines

To round off this tour, you will take part in a special luncheon where food and wines are matched.

12pm: Lunch
